Dear Ms. Finch:

EPA has reviewed the Final Interim Corrective Actions Measures (ICAM) Completion Report (CR) submitted via electronic mail on June 10, 2014. The ICAM CR was submitted pursuant to a Unilateral Administrative Order (Order) [Docket No. RCRA-7003-09-2013-0002] issued on March 15, 2013. Under paragraph 38 of the Order, NASA is required to take interim action to stabilize contamination present at the Former Soils Fill Area (FSFA) at NASA Ames Research Center located in Moffett Field, California. The ICAM CR documents the ICAM taken by NASA to implement erosion control measures and perform maintenance and monitoring around the largest peninsula at the Former Soils Fill Area, also known as Area of Investigation 14. The ICAM CR adequately addresses comments from EPA and San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) staff on earlier versions of the document, thereby satisfying the requirements of paragraph 39 of the Order. By this letter, EPA is approving the Final ICAM CR pursuant to paragraph 67 of the Order.

Work to implement a final Corrective Measure for the FSFA is still required and, as previously agreed upon, NASA may complete the work under the provisions of the Order or under the provisions of a final Federal Facilities Agreement currently being negotiated between NASA, EPA and the Water Board.
